

Call for Entries

The winning entry will be used as the commemorative poster for the 2020 Fairfax Festival to be held on October 8, 2020 at Kaw Point Park, on the Fairfax Industrial Association (FIA) website, FIA emails blasts, and social media.

The Fairfax District is believed to be the first planned industrial district in the country and currently houses over 130 businesses, employs over 10,000 people and generates over \$5.4 billion in annual sales. Business sizes range from very small, one-employee businesses to large companies employing more than 3,500 people. Many are world famous: the Fairfax Kellogg's plant makes nearly 60% of all of the Cheez-Its, CertainTeed is the largest insulation manufacturing plant in the world, Owens Corning makes the famous Pink Panther insulation and The Fairfax General Motors Assembly Plant makes the Chevrolet Malibu and new Cadillac XT4 SUV. Between the 3 Pipeline Companies (Magellan, Phillips & Exxon), 95% of the Kansas City metropolitan area's supply for unleaded gasoline and diesel and 100% of the jet fuel comes out of Fairfax. The district was founded in 1922. The Fairfax Industrial Association, FIA, was established in 1951.

ELIGIBLE ARTISTS

- Open to all amateur and professional artists.

JUDGING

- The Fairfax Industrial Association Membership will vote to determine the top ten entries.
- From the ten selected by membership, the Fairfax Festival Committee will select the winner.

MEDIA & SPECIFICATIONS

- Artwork should **not include themes used in past posters (B25 Bomber, Lewis & Clark, Rosie the Riveter, Union Pacific)**. For more info, please see our website: <https://fiack.org/posterchallenge/>
- Artwork must contain year "2020" and "Fairfax Festival"
- One entry per person.
- Finished product should be 11 x 17, horizontal or vertical design.
- Submit a .jpg of artwork to rchambers@fiack.org.
- Winner must submit a 300 DPI .pdf of entry to rchambers@fiack.org

RIGHT OF REFUSAL

The Fairfax Festival committee has the right to refuse artwork if it is substantially different from the specifications given or is deemed inappropriate for the contest.
